

PROPOSAL FOR SKATEPARK IN MENHENIOT VILLAGE

At its public meeting last week, councillors had been asked to consider giving permission for the Menheniot Skate Park Group to build a skate ramp on the playing fields adjacent to the tennis club. The Chair of the Parish Council, Cllr Jerry Tucker would like to reassure all residents that the request they discussed was not a formal planning application.

Representatives from the MSPG were told that the Parish Council would not consider any proposals for a skate ramp until a proper planning application had been submitted to Cornwall Council. Part of that process will require a public consultation with residents on all aspects of the scheme, along with detailed plans and assessments on any possible impact that the project might have on the locality.

If a formal planning application is made by the MSPG, the Parish Council will ensure that all residents will have the opportunity to view the proposals beforehand, and be able to make their comments directly to their elected councillors before any decision is made.
